Dear Parents and Carers

As you will be aware, the next round of industrial action by teacher is due to begin next week and the NEU will be encouraging strike action on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, March 15<sup>th</sup>, and March 16<sup>th</sup>.

We are writing to provide you with advance notice of what we are planning for all three days to assist you with any alternative arrangements you may need to make. It will necessitate some year groups being out of school for some of the time.

Accordingly, we are planning for:

- **March 2<sup>nd</sup>** – Years 7, 11 and 6<sup>th</sup> form to attend school as usual
- **March 15<sup>th</sup>** – Years 8, 11 and 6<sup>th</sup> form to attend as usual
- **March 16<sup>th</sup>** – Years 9, 11 and 6<sup>th</sup> form to attend as usual

This plan will allow us to cover all other lessons and provide the vast majority of our students with meaningful timetabled lessons in school.

This plan is subject to change but we will let you know as soon as possible if there are any substantial changes.
